

Outdoor Planter DIY

Step 1:

Decide the height of your planter by using the silver fir, use the small cut ends to fill the front of your planter.

Step 2:

Put in your tall pieces of fir, we find its best to work in triangles for design. Placing one piece at the back and two pieces on the side works well!

Step 3:

Now its time to add your cedar branches. Placing the larger peices between your fir and then cutting smaller pieces for the front, if you want a cascading look its best to angle your cedar slightly down at this point!



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Step 4:

Now it's time to add pine, the "fancy" greens! We put this in the spots that look a little empty.

Step 5:

Now its time add your sticks, in this planter we added about 5 sticks of alpine huck. You can also add berries, bows, bells and balls at this point.

Step 6:

In this planter, we stepped back and decided to pop three branches of magnolia leaves in it! And this is the final product!
